

CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

The following information is for the advice off all prospective members. This information contains details of the obligations and requirements accepted by all members with regard to the payment of annual subscriptions, renewal of and resignation from membership and the penalties that may result from failure to follow the guidelines. No membership application will be processed unless the signature of the applicant appears to acknowledge that they have read and fully understood these terms and condition.

1. APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP

I understand that if accepted for Membership, I will abide by the Constitution and Rules of the New Norfolk Golf Club, and will be held accountable for all monies owing to the Club, relating to my subscription, from the date of acceptance, and any costs incurred by the Club in recovering any outstanding subscriptions or other costs in line with my obligations under the constitution until such time as I tender my written resignation.

I understand that, notwithstanding any further information I may receive, my application for membership or any subsequent application to transfer to another category of membership is not fully approved until such time as it has been presented to a meeting of the Board. Under normal circumstances, the application would be presented to the next Board Meeting after receipt of the application.

I understand that when this form, duly completed, is received by the Club, I may play with payment of green fees and may play in competition fields to enable me to return five cards for handicap purposes.

The following clauses of the Constitution are relevant to member applications:

3.5 Admission and rejection of new members

- 3.5.1. The board must consider an application for membership at the next board meeting held after it receives:
 - a. the application for membership; and
- 3.5.2. The board must decide at the meeting, in its absolute discretion, whether to accept or reject the application.
- 3.5.3. If a majority of the board members present and voting at the meeting vote to accept the applicant as a member, the applicant must be accepted as a member in the class of membership applied for, subject to any waiting period.
- 3.5.4. If the board decides to reject an application, the secretary of the association must, as soon as possible, give the applicant notice of the decision in a manner determined by the board.
- 3.5.5. The secretary shall promptly forward to every admitted applicant an account for payment of subscription fees and will enter the name, address of the new member and email address, and the date of becoming a member, in the register of members.
- 3.5.6. An applicant whose application for membership has been rejected has no right of appeal against their rejection under this clause.

The following clauses of the Constitution are relevant to renewal

3.6. Membership renewal and re-joining

- 3.6.1. Members will renew membership upon receipt of renewal invoice and that the relevant fee is paid by the designated date of payment. If renewal payment is not received by the designated date, the member will become non-financial and have to re-apply for membership again.
- 3.6.2. Upon renewal a member must provide details of any change in their personal details, and any other information reasonably required by the association.
- 3.6.3. A member who has resigned from the association or otherwise forfeited their membership and later desires to re-join may be subject to the same process of admission to membership as any new member who has not previously been a member of the association. The board has the right to determine what, if any, nomination fee is required of a member re-joining under this clause.

The following clauses of the Constitution relate to register of members:

3.7. Register of members

- 3.7.1. The board must keep a register of members of the association.
- 3.7.2. The register must include the following particulars for each member:
 - a. the full name of the member;
 - b. the postal or residential address of the member;
 - c. the email address of the member
 - d. the date of admission as a member;
 - e. the date of death or time of resignation of the member;
 - f. details about the termination or reinstatement of membership;
 - g. any other particulars the board or the members at a general meeting decide.
- 3.7.3. Having regard to privacy and confidentiality considerations, inspection of the register may be available to members of the association.

3.8. Use of information on register of members

- 3.8.1. Subject to the Act, confidentiality considerations and privacy laws, the register of members may be used solely to further the objects of the association, as the board considers appropriate.

The following clauses of the Constitution relate to resignation:

4.1 Resignation of a member

- 4.1.1. A member may resign from the association by giving a written notice of resignation to the secretary.
- 4.1.2. The resignation takes effect at:
 - a. the time the notice is received by the secretary; or
 - b. if a later time is stated in the notice, the later time.
